WHAT MALBEC CAN BE!

Mendoza is a viticultural paradise. Its high altitude, desert climate provides hot days, cool nights, amazing quality of sunlight and a dry harvest.

We began with estate-grown grapes from the Uco Valley (one of Mendoza's southernmost growing regions), vinified with exacting attention to detail including a post-fermentation maceration of 15 days. Then aged in French and American oak barrels for 10 months.

From the start, you'll be captivated by the bright, vivid rose color; as if taken from a stained glass window and backlit by the sun. Then you'll notice the steady stream of miniscule bubbles. Aromas of ripe raspberries and flower petals lead to luscious flavors of red and tropical fruit layered with nutty spices and delicate acidity.

A wine as rare as the savage beauty that bore it, only 17,000 bottles were made, from our desert vineyard in Lujan de Cuyo - Mendoza, Argentina.
